

The 12 Apostles

- 1. Andrew crucified
- 2. Bartholomew beaten then crucified
- 3. James, son of Alphaeus stoned to death
- 4. James, son of Zebedee beheaded
- 5. John exiled for his faith (after a failed attempt to fry him in cooking oil) died of old age
- 6. Judas (not Iscariot) stoned to death
- 7. Matthew speared to death
- 8. Peter crucified upside down
- 9. Philip crucified
- 10. Simon crucified
- 11. Thomas speared to death
- 12. Matthias stoned to death

If you find happiness, people may be jealous. Be happy anyway.


The good you do today may be forgotten tomorrow. Do good anyway.


Trust

- Initial trust: A person is able to *trust* Jesus Christ, the Church, a Christian believer.
- not the same as active personal faith.
- TRUST = a bridge to God



Curiosity

- Spiritual curiosity:
 intrigued about Jesus,
 from awareness to
 something
- Not yet open to personal change essentially passive, but it is more than mere trust.




Spiritual Openness

- Open to the possibility of personal spiritual change.
- Not a commitment to change.



Spiritual Seeking

- Spiritual seeking: The person moves to actively seeking to know God
- "dating with a purpose" engaged in an urgent spiritual quest
- Yes or no to Christianity




Are you intentional?

Heb 11.1 "Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and the evidence of things unseen."


The word brings Faith


God's thoughts


faith

Balance grace & obedience

Imitation

- God will be with you




Do what Jesus does

- 10. Promise without forgetting. (Proverbs 13:12)


Jesus prays

- Rom 12.12 Rejoice in hope, endure in affliction, persevere in prayer.




Community prayer

Mt 6.7-15 – Jesus teaches us the "Our Father." This prayer is the good news, a community prayer.






Strength from God

Discipline brings the fruit of righteousness and peace




Fasting

He knows u can handle



- Obedience is better than sacrifice. 1 Sm 15.22




Listen to God


Transformation

- Poor in spirit, humble, obedient




